Signs of Wound Infection

Increased pain

**If the wound becomes increasingly painful,
it may be a sign of infection.**

Redness

A red, swollen, or warm area around the wound can be a sign of infection.

Swelling

Swelling around the wound is a common sign of infection.

4

Discharge

A yellow or green discharge from the wound can indicate the presence of bacteria.

Foul odor

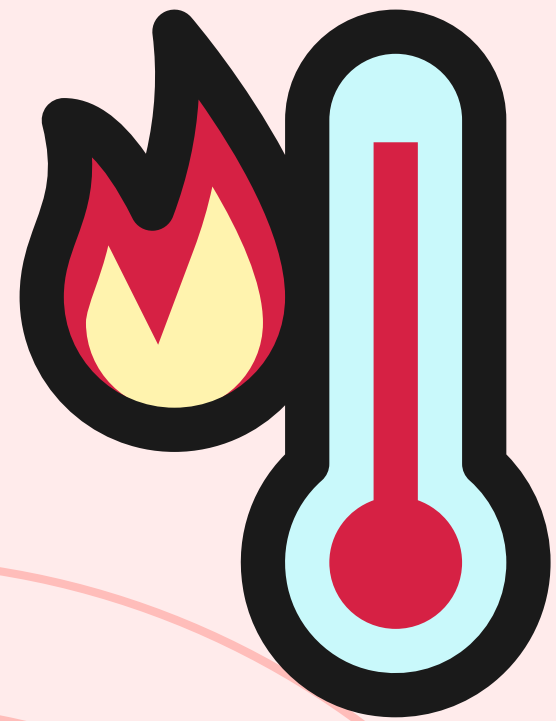
A foul or rancid odor from the wound is a strong indication of infection.

Temperature Rise



A fever or increased body temperature can be a sign of a systemic infection.

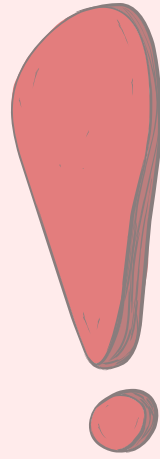
Delayed healing

as expected,
or if new symptoms appear.**
